**GET A BEHIND THE SCENES TOUR OF THE DSO's MAX M. FISHER CENTER & ARCHIVES SATURDAY MARCH 1ST**

**DETROIT** – The Detroit Historical Society's "Behind the Scenes" Saturday tour series continues with a tour featuring the Max M. Fisher Music Center & Archives on Saturday, March 1st from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The Max M. Fisher Music Center & Archives, a performing arts complex known as "The Max," was unveiled by the Detroit Symphony Orchestra (DSO) in 2003. It has hosted a variety of jazz, pop, and family concerts. It has also been a destination for some of the world's greatest classical music by the world-renowned DSO. Many of the symphony's records were lost over the years or reside in repositories. The archives are a new addition to the Max, and you will be among the first to explore the official archive room of the DSO.

The tour is \$20 for Detroit Historical Society members and \$25 for guests. Reservations are limited, and advance registration is highly recommended. Payment must accompany your reservation. Telephone reservations can be accepted with a Visa or Mastercard Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tickets are not sold the day of the tour.
