Join us on Saturday, March 25th at 10:30 a.m. as Detroit Historical Commission President and longtime Detroit Club member John L. Booth, II, guides participants through this beautiful building, which has served as a hub of activity for many city business and civic leaders over the years.

The Detroit Club was founded in 1882 by attorney Samuel T. Douglas and banker James Campbell as place where people could meet to exchange news, do business and promote fellowship. In celebration of its 10th anniversary, the flourishing Club moved into its present clubhouse at the corner of Fort and Cass. Designed by renowned architect Wilson Eyre Jr. of Philadelphia, the four-story brick and stone Romanesque Revival building has served as the stage for many dramatic events of Twentieth Century Detroit.

After the tour, a light lunch will be served in one of the many conference rooms.

The cost for this event is \$35 for Society members and \$40 for non-members. Reservations are limited and advance registration is highly recommended. Payment must accompany your reservation.
