DETROIT HISTORICAL MUSEUM STORE SELLING ROWS OF FOUR
WHILE SUPPLIES LAST

DETROIT – If you missed the opportunity to buy seats from **Tiger Stadium**, this may be your last chance. The **Detroit Historical Society** has rows of four seats literally mined from the legendary ballpark at Michigan and Trumbull before its final demolition and is making them available for sale now at the **Detroit Historical Museum Store** while supplies last.

The cost for an authentic row of four seats is \$400. No phone reservations are being accepted. All seats must be purchased at the Store and picked up at time of purchase.

In addition, the Store has other Tiger Stadium items available for sale including seatbacks, vendor uniform shirts and jackets, Ernie Harwell cassettes, programs, baseball card sets and other souvenir items.

The Detroit Historical Museum Store is open 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Wednesday through Friday, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays and Noon to 5 p.m. on Sundays. Museum admission is free for the entire month of July, thanks to the generous support of **PVS Chemicals**.
