KIDS INVITED TO ENJOY THE 8th ANNUAL “TREATS IN THE STREETS” AT THE DETROIT HISTORICAL MUSEUM ON SUNDAY, OCTOBER 25TH

DETROIT -- Celebrate Halloween and go back in time as the **Detroit Historical Society** presents its eighth annual “**Treats in the Streets**” on **Sunday, October 25 from 1 to 4 p.m.** Taking place in the **Detroit Historical Museum**’s signature *Streets of Old Detroit* exhibit, this event is the perfect, safe opportunity for kids ages 3 to 12 to dress up as their favorite cartoon character, ghost, goblin, celebrity, super hero or historic figure.

Admission to the Museum is free for children 12 and under dressed in a costume and Detroit Historical Society Members. “Puppet Guy” **Richard Paul** will entertain guests with his “Ha Ha Halloween Show” in the Louise C. Booth Auditorium at 1:45 p.m. and 2:45 p.m. Children ages 5-12 can enjoy the “Get that Ghoul” history hunt, a fun and educational scavenger hunt. The *Got Milk?* Campaign will be on hand to distribute health information and take pictures of guests wearing milk moustaches. In addition, there will be treats (without the tricks!), pumpkin decorating, and lots of fun!

The Detroit Historical Museum, located at 5401 Woodward Ave. (NW corner of Kirby) in Detroit’s Cultural Center area, is open to the public Wednesday through Friday from 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Sunday from Noon to 5 p.m. On Mondays and Tuesdays, the Museum is not open to the public but available for group tours by calling **(313) 833-7979**. Adult admission is \$6. Seniors (60+), college students with valid college ID, and youth ages 5-17 pay \$4. Admission for children ages four and under is free. Parking in the Museum’s lot is \$4 at all times. Permanent exhibits include the famous *Streets of Old Detroit*, *Frontiers to Factories*, *The Motor City*, and *The Glancy Trains*. New exhibits include *VeloCity: Detroit’s Need for Speed*; *Hero or Villain? Metro Detroit’s Legacy of Leadership*; *Fabulous 5: Detroit’s Snack Food Superstars*; *Detroit Trivia*; and *Automotive Showplace*, spotlighting the
