



Group Tour Planning Information Sheet

Decide on your date and time.

The Detroit Historical Museum is open for tours Tuesday through Friday. Guided tours begin at 10 a.m. or 12:30 p.m.

Choose your lunch option.

The Detroit Historical Museum does not provide lunches, nor is there an opportunity to purchase a lunch. Your group may bring sack lunches to eat in our lunchroom (reserved for an additional \$15 charge).

Choose your chaperones.

Chaperones and teachers are an integral part of any visit and are responsible for ensuring students' respect for the tour and the institution.

Teachers receive free admission to all tours and programs, unless otherwise noted. Schools may also bring one free chaperone per ten students. Additional chaperones are admitted for the same per participant price as students.

Make your reservation.

Fill out the online registration form at least two weeks prior to the date you want to reserve for your program. We recommend you select at least three potential dates for your tour, as space is limited during the peak season.

Confirm your program.

You will receive a confirmation letter and invoice once we receive your reservation. Please contact us with any questions you have about your program.



Make your payment.

Guided tours are \$5 per participant. Teachers receive free admission. Once chaperone for every ten students also receive free admission. Additional chaperones are admitted for the same per participant price as students.

Full payment is due no later than two weeks prior to your tour date. Make your check or money order payable to the Detroit Historical Society. We also accept Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express. You may also pay in cash during regular hours at the Detroit Historical Museum.

Payment is non-refundable, but we will help you reschedule your program in the event of an unavoidable cancellation.
