- Free after-hours parking for up to 55 vehicles, as available. Parking during Museum operating hours, as available, is \$6 per vehicle.
- General admission for your guests to all open museum exhibits is included for all rentals of over \$1,000. For smaller rentals entire museum access can be included for an additional \$200 fee.

Detroit Historical Museum Frequently Asked Questions

What kinds of events can you help me host at the Detroit Historical Museum?

The Detroit Historical Museum is the perfect place to host weddings, corporate events, birthday celebrations, nonprofit fundraisers and more! We are able to accommodate 25 to 2,000 guests. The Detroit Historical Society does not allow any type of event that opens ticket sales to the general public. Let our event specialists help you determine how much space you need.

Can I rent the Museum during normal business hours?

In many cases, you can host your event during regular hours. Ask our event specialist if your event qualifies.

How many hours can I rent space for?

Events are typically four hours in length with an hour and half beforehand for set-up and an hour afterward for clean-up. If you need more event or set-up time, please inquire about the fee for additional hours. Please note that evening events must end by midnight.

Is parking available for my guests?

For events that take place after museum hours, guests may park in our 55-space, secure parking lot adjacent to the Museum, as space is available. During museum operating hours the current per-vehicle parking rate of \$6 will be charged.

What audio/visual equipment is available at the Museum?

The basic audio/visual package includes a microphone, speaker and podium, while the advanced package includes (in addition) a wireless microphone, lap-top, screen, and projector. There is an additional \$25 per hour fee, per hour, for an audio visual technician.

May I bring my own caterer?

You are welcome to use any licensed caterer of your choice. The Detroit Historical Museum is not equipped with a full service kitchen. Cooking is not permitted on the premise. Please find our list of suggested caterers listed at the end of this packet.

Does the Detroit Historical Society have a liquor license?

Although we do not hold a liquor license, you may serve adult beverages at your event. Nonprofits may apply for a special liquor license through the State of Michigan Liquor Control Commission. Private events and businesses may serve adult beverages as long as there is no cost for the beverages, food or to attend the event. Contact our event specialist for more information.

Is security available?

There will be a minimum of two Society staff members present for all rental events. Security can be added to your rental for an additional fee. The Museum reserves the right to require security, depending on the size and nature of your event.

What is included with my event rental?

The Society can provide the use of our on-site tables and chairs at no additional cost for indoor events. Furniture to be used outdoors must be rented from an outside company.

Access to the entire museum is included for rentals of over \$1,000. Entire museum access can be added to smaller rentals for an additional \$200. Linens, décor, food and beverages must be provided by an outside vendor. The Society is willing to procure any outside rentals you desire for a 20% service fee. The usage of the Museum's parking lot is included for all rentals outside of museum hours.

Does the museum allow equipment from outside rental companies?

You are welcome to rent additional equipment from outside rental companies. The museum staff is not responsible for the load in, set up, teardown, or storage of additional rental equipment.
