Event: Detroit Historical Society's Course of History Golf Classic

Date: Monday, September 21<sup>st</sup>, 2020

Dress Code: Soft spikes only with golf slacks or Bermuda shorts and a collared shirt. Denim jeans, gym shorts, and short shorts are not permitted on the course.

Personal Protective Gear: You will be provided with personal protective gear as part of your welcome to the outing. You are welcome to wear your mask on the course but the only location where masks are currently required is the Pro Shop. This may be updated to be in adherence with regulations set forth by the Governor and the Golf Association of Michigan.

Format: Scramble with a Shotgun Start

- *alternative plans for beginning with set tee times have been set in case social distancing measures change before September 21st.*
- *The number of golfers per cart will adhere to recommendations from the Governor and the Golf Association of Michigan in effect on September 21.*

Time Frame:

- 8 a.m. warm up facilities open with an outdoor continental breakfast, Bloody Mary bar, and coffee bar to start the day
- 10:30 a.m. Shotgun start with a Barbeque lunch provided on the course
- Strolling dinner, open bar and awards ceremony immediately following the round on the clubhouse patio

*For the safety of our guests, we are prepared to provide boxed continental breakfasts on golf carts as well as an on course attended Bloody Mary bar, coffee bar and lunch stations, should new conditions require it.*

*The strolling dinner will take place outdoors on the clubhouse lawn with well-spaced seating and chef attended stations.*
